

Anderson Robbins Research (D) / Shaw & Company Research (R) N = 1,005 registered voters (654 landline, 351 cell phone)

Interviews Conducted: June 21-23, 2015

Questions 1-6, 12-22 and 28-53 are for release after 6:00 P.M. ET Wed., June 24, 2015. Questions 8-10 and 23-27 are for release after 6:00 P.M. ET Thurs., June 25, 2015. Questions 7 and 11 are held for future release.

Methodology

The Fox News Poll is conducted under the joint direction of Anderson Robbins Research (D) and Shaw & Company Research (R). The poll was conducted by telephone with live interviewers June 21-23, 2015 among a random national sample of 1,005 registered voters (RV). Results based on the full sample have a margin of sampling error of plus or minus three percentage points.

Landline and cell phone telephone numbers were randomly selected for inclusion in the survey using a probability proportionate to size method, which means that phone numbers for each state are proportional to the number of voters in each state.

Results are of registered voters, unless otherwise noted.

Results from Fox News polls before February 2011 were conducted by Opinion Dynamics Corp.
